Our vision is to be a grace-filled community sharing good news on our estate, and in the wider area with the aim to be a growing, church-planting church, especially reaching the urban poor. We are affiliated with Partnership UK, The North West Partnership and our existing Pastor is a member of the FIEC Pastor's Network.

We are looking to recruit a man to work as an Associate Pastor or Co-Pastor alongside our existing Pastor, and with the support and supervision of our Elders. They would take a lead in developing a culture of evangelism across the whole church, and help to nurture and disciple church members.

The successful candidate will:

- Have a heart to reach the urban poor.
- Be willing to move onto and become involved in the community on the estate.
- Model a commitment to personal evangelism and prayer.
- Train and equip church members in personal evangelism.
- Take on some of the Preaching responsibility within the church.
- Identify key individuals to train, disciple and invest in to equip for works of service.

Hours: The appointment will be full time for 37.5 hours per week, although we are willing to be flexible for the right candidate.
